“Don’t Be A Stinkbug!”



“I Will CHOOSE A Good Attitude!”



“You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had.”
- Philippians 2:5

This week, we continue the series called, “Bugs”. In this lesson, we use the stinkbug to help us remember that we have a choice whether or not we have a “stinky” attitude.

Read:

Job

Ask:

- What happened in Job’s life?
- What kind of attitude did he have?

Say:

All of us have bad days. Sometimes our hair won’t cooperate. Other times, we face difficulties with people we work with. Every day we are tested to see if we will have a Godly attitude or not.

Too often, we let our attitudes be determined by what our day is like. If things go well, we have a great attitude. If things go badly, we have a stinky attitude. Our attitude is a choice. It is not determined by others. We should have the same attitude that Jesus had - no matter what!

Ask/Discuss:

- What determines your attitude? Do you normally have a stinky attitude?
- How can you change your attitude?

Pray:

Lead your child in a prayer of repentance for having the wrong attitude at times. Pray that God will help them to choose the right attitude, just as Jesus did. Pray that with God’s help, they will make the right choice for the right attitude and never ever be a stinkbug.
