



The Gospel at Creation

Text: Genesis 1:26-28

Central Truth: Human beings are the crown of God's creative work as we are made in His image with the ability to have a personal relationship with Him.

v. 26a **I. We Were Created by God: Precious**

Notice that the creation account is purposely arranged in ascending order. This emphasizes that human beings are the crown of God's creative handiwork! This directly contradicts evolution.

v. 27 **II. We Were Created like God: Divine Pattern**

We are made in God's image. Theologians use the Latin phrase "**Imago Dei**" – which means *image of God*.

Created (Hebrew – *bara*; cf. v.1) this verb conveys the special, creative activity that only God can do! God creates "**Ex Nihilo**" – *out of nothing!*

Image (Hebrew – *selem*) it speaks of a resemblance or representation. The text emphasizes that we are made in God's image. Nothing else is described this way!

When God created human beings, He created two sexes and both share the image of God. **Gender** is a gift from God.

vv. 26b, 28 **III. We Were Created for God: Purpose**

God created us to be His vice-rulers on earth.

v. 26b NASB – **rule over**, KJV – **have dominion over**; literally, this word means to tread down, to subjugate.

v. 28 God gives five commands:

1. **Be fruitful**
2. **multiply**
3. **fill** (replenish) – this speaks of procreation which takes both sexes.
4. **subdue**
5. **rule** (dominion) – this stresses rulership.



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
