Central Truth: Only in and through Christ can we attain a right relationship with God.

v.23 I. The Tragedy of the Human Condition

1. **Past sin – have sinned** (Greek – *hamartano*) Literally, it means to miss the mark or target. This verb is in the past tense. All people have missed the mark.

Two main ways to think about our sin:

- A. **By nature** (cf. Romans 5:12): _____
- B. **By choice**: _____

2. **Present sin** – NASB – **fall short**, KJV – **come short**; this verb means to fall behind, to lack or want, to be too late! This verb is the present tense. It emphasizes the present, up-to-date, current, continual nature of our sin.

3. **Perfect standard** – As fallen, sinful human beings we cannot meet, measure up to, qualify, or reach God’s standard of righteousness.

v.24 II. The Triumph of Divine Intervention

Being justified – This is a legal, courtroom term. It means to declare righteous or to pronounce not guilty. Justification includes a double transaction.

NASB – **as a gift**, KJV & NIV – **freely**; literally, this means a gift!

Redemption – It means to secure a release by the payment of a ransom price. Jesus’ death and shed blood on the cross has bought our release or forgiveness of sin.



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
