



Sowing Wickedness – Reaping Wrath (Scene I)

Text: 1 Kings 21:1-7

Central Truth: We practice the deadly sin of covetousness when we focus on obtaining earthly possessions rather than seeking God.

vv.1-2 I. The Selfish Request

We need to notice that the sole focus of Ahab’s attention is upon himself and what he wants! He misses a great opportunity to lead his nation in a time of national revival. In the coveting of Naboth’s vineyard, the king breaks the 10th commandment.

v.3 II. The Scriptural Refusal

Naboth was unwilling to sell his property to the king because of a conviction based on the Word of God (cf. Leviticus 25:23-28; Numbers 36:7). God had given O.T. Israel very specific laws regulating the selling and buying of property. Ancestral, tribal lands were to stay in the possession of the original family owners. All land in reality belonged to God!

vv.4-7 III. The Sinful Reprisals (2-Fold)

v.4 1. Ahab’s Pouting: NASB, NIV – sullen, KJV – heavy (Hebrew – sar). The root means to be stubborn and rebellious. It is an attitude which rejects reproof and correction. NASB – vexed, KJV – displeased, NIV – angry; literally, it means to boil up!

vv.5-7 2. Jezebel’s Probing

Three Practical Applications (What not to do!)

- 1. Ahab was focused on feeding his FLESH rather than his FAITH.
2. Ahab was flagrantly forsaking God’s LAW rather than following the LORD.
3. Jezebel was facilitating TREACHERY rather than TRUTH.



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
